





Year 6 Walk of Honour and Final Goodbye - Friday 15 December



As Paulo Coelho once said, "If you are brave enough to say goodbye, life will reward you with a new hello."


We wish all our Year 6 students all the very best as they head off to the wonderful world of secondary education, supported in their new journey by our colleagues at Gloucester High School.
